On behalf of the Chairman, U.P. Jal Nigam (Urban) online e-tenders on percentage rate basis in Two bid system for following works under Amrut 2.0 Programme are hereby invited from there puted contractors having requisite work experience & financial capabilities. The bidders should submit their bids only if they consider themselves eligible and are in possession of all the requisite documents.

- The Bid should be valid for 120 days from the last date of submission of bids.
- If the date of opening of technical bid happens to be a holiday, the bid shall be opened on the next

working day at the same time for which no separate communication shall be sent.

5. Bidders having criminal record will not be allowed to participate in Bid process.
6. A person registered with any State Bar Council will not be eligible to participate in the Bid.
7. As per Government norms GST at applicable rates will be paid extra.

8. Joint Venture:-

The Joint Venture is allowed with maximum two member out of which lead member has to be an Indian firm/company. Foreign companies can be part of Joint Venture.

- a. The lead Member of the JV/Consortium must have minimum 51% of the Stake Holding. Member of Joint venture, other than the lead member, should have at least 30% Stake Holding.
- b. Lead member should have a Solvency of at least 51% of the total Solvency required. Lead member should have a turnover of atleast 51% of the total turnover required.
- c. Lead member should have at least 30% technical experience of required technical experience for projects >Rs. 25Cr.
- d. The aggregate Technical Eligibility and Financial Eligibility of JV/Consortium can be considered for meeting the minimum required criteria provided JV partner (other than lead Partner) holds at least 30% of the equity (for consideration of Technical Eligibility) and 30% of the equity (for consideration of Financial Eligibility) in the JV/Consortium.
- e. A member of JV/Consortium shall not participate either in individual capacity or as a member of another JV/Consortium in the same tender.
- f. Tender form shall only be submitted in the name of the JV/Consortium. Tender fees may be submitted by lead partner/JV.
- g. A single Performance Guarantee shall be submitted by the JV/Consortium in the name of the JV/Consortium.
- h. All the member of the JV/Consortium of Bidders shall be liable jointly and severally for the execution of the project.

For further details and methodology Clauses 2.20.2 and 3.6 of Instructions to the Bidder (ITB) must be referred.

9. Eligibility:-

(a) Experience

Contractors who inter alia fulfill the following requirements shall be eligible to apply.

Firm should have successfully completed and commissioned *similar works* during last Ten years as on date of publication of NIT, satisfying either of following: -

- i. Three similar completed, tested and commissioned works each costing not less than the amount equal to 30% of estimated cost put to tender (i.e. Rs. 479.11 Lacs)
- OR
- ii. Two similar completed, tested and commissioned works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of estimated cost put to tender (i.e.Rs. 638.81Lacs.)
- OR
- iii. One similar completed, tested and commissioned work of aggregate cost not less than the amount equal to 60% of estimated cost put to tender (i.e.Rs. 958.21Lacs)
